WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program ("State"), provides loans and/or grants to municipal and county governments and grants to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the acquisition and development of lands for outdoor recreation and conservation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dumont desires to further the public interest by obtaining a grant of \$235,632.00 from the State to fund the following project(s):

0210-19-050 GINA'S FIELD IMPROVEMENTS

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body resolves that Christopher Tully or the successor to the office of Administrator is hereby authorized to:

- (a) make application for such a loan and/or such a grant,
- (b) provide additional application information and furnish such documents as may be required,
- (c) act as the authorized correspondent of the above-named applicant; and

WHEREAS, the State shall determine if the application is complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the Green Acres Program, and notify the applicant of the amount of the funding award; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is willing to use the State's funds in accordance with such rules, regulations and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the State for the above-named project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Governing Body of the Borough of Dumont that:

- 1. The Administrator of the above-named body is hereby authorized to execute an agreement and any amendment thereto with the State known as Gina's Field Improvements and; [Note: Please authorize only one official to sign the project agreement on behalf of the local government or nonprofit.]
- 2. The applicant has its matching share of the project, if a match is required, in the amount of \$706,896.00
- 3. In the event the State's funds are less than the total project cost specified above, the applicant has the balance of funding necessary to complete the project, and;
- 4. The applicant agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations in its performance of the project.
- 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

AUTHORIZATION OF ROAD CLOSURE DUE TO SEWER EMERGENCY REPAIR

WHEREAS, the Borough discovered a blocked sanitary sewer pipeline on Columbia Avenue approximately 35 feet east of its manhole at the intersection of Cortland Avenue; and

WHEREAS, during the efforts to clear the blockage, evidence showed that the sewer pipe was broken; and

WHEREAS, to address this public health and safety condition, the Borough called in Montana Construction, Inc of Lodi, New Jersey to setup a bypass pumping operation to provide sewer service to upstream users of the sanitary sewer system. The bypass pumping required a 24-hour per day operation which was overseen by Montana Construction; and

WHEREAS, due to ongoing work by CSX Railroad at the Columbia Avenue and Cortland Avenue rail crossing, the Borough made contact with CSX Railroad representatives to investigate the sewer break which is likely the result of CSX's work; and

WHEREAS, during the emergency, the Borough engaged its Borough Engineer to assist the Borough in investigating the sewer break, work with CSX, and design a new parallel sewer pipeline to re-establish sewer service; and

WHEREAS, through Riverside Co-op, of which Dumont is a member, the Borough hired J. Fletcher Creamer & Son, Inc to perform the emergency sewer repair; and

WHEREAS, the repair work requires that the full width of Columbia Avenue be closed overnight for approximately a week beginning February 10, 2021 or soon thereafter between Addon Street in Bergenfield and Courtland Avenue in Dumont;

BE IT RESOLVED, the Governing Body of Dumont authorizes the road closure of Columbia Avenue as specified above.
